Expansion & Renovation

Today, KMHC provides 58 long-term beds and 10 short-term beds.

The new construction will add 25 long-term care beds and 5 short-term care beds for a total of 73 beds.

The expansion comprises construction of an entirely new, 2-storey facility, as well as renovation of outpatient services.

Construction is scheduled to be complete in fall of 2019.
