The Kateri Memorial Hospital Centre is hosting an information session to take place on Wednesday, July 17, 2013 from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Kahnawà:ke Peacekeepers' Station, Community room.

The purpose of the information session is to explain the tendering process of the KMHC Renovation and Expansion Project. The presentation will focus on:

- Overall scope, schedule and phasing of the work; Application of the MCK Tendering Policy to the project and how the policy is to be implemented;
- Requirements for Mohawk Content in the contract;
- Coordination of Kahnawà:ke and Quebec workers' compensation regimes on the contract;
- Jurisdictional issues regarding labor.

The presentation is aimed at general contractors, subcontractors, suppliers and tradespeople interested in participating on the project.

Representatives from KMHC, Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke, and Tewatohnhi'saktha will be making presentations on a variety of topics that are important for the project. There will be an opportunity for questions.
